# Deliverance





#### The main idea of Exodus 12:21-28:

#### God delivers his people from death by the blood of the Lamb.

The following questions can be used during a family worship time. Take time as a family this week to talk about the Story and what you are learning as you read. The hymns on the next pages are from our worship service. Sing them together as a family during your family worship time this week.

#### **Discussion questions:**

What are some wonderful things that have happened in your life? Did you thank God for them? Besides expressing your thanks in prayer, how else can you show God your appreciation?

Have you ever felt unqualified or unable to do something, as Moses did? How did you handle it?

What can you learn about the character of God from the story of the Israelites' deliverance from slavery?

What is one area of your life where you tend to focus more on your limitations than God's ability to work through you?

### As a family:

We all have our "I could never" and "I hope God never asks me to..." moments. Where are the places you tend to resist God's call? What things are you sure you could never do? As you honetly reflect on these questions, place them before the Lord, one by one. Admit your fear and resistance. Ask for new courage and boldness to follow God, even when you feel that you have nothing to offer or that your past disqualifies you. Commit to follow God, as best you can, no matter what He calls you to do.
